

Part III : 1990-1996

During the 1990s the consciousness of the history of nephrology became general. Most nephrological journals began to run historical articles on a regular basis, which is reflected in the increasing annual numbers of papers on the subject. However nephrology remained (and remains) a neglected subject for general historians of medicine.
